Job Title: Music Leader – Part-Time

Position Summary:

The Music Leader is responsible for planning, coordinating, and leading music for worship services and special events in a way that supports the mission and vision of the church. This part-time role requires a spiritually mature and musically gifted individual who can lead congregational singing, work with volunteers, and create an atmosphere of meaningful worship.

Key Responsibilities:

- **Worship Leadership**
 - Lead congregational singing during weekly worship services.
 - Select songs that align with the sermon theme and convictions of the church.
 - Selecting contemporary worship music.
- **Planning & Coordination**
 - Collaborate with the pastor plan and organize weekly services.

- **Team Development**
 - Recruit, train, and encourage volunteer musicians and vocalists.
 - Foster a Christ-centered environment focused on unity and excellence in worship.
- **Administration & Communication**
 - Communicate song selections, rehearsal schedules, and service plans in advance.
 - Manage the music ministry budget.

Qualifications:

- A musically gifted, spiritually mature, biblically grounded Christian.
- A lifestyle congruent with the biblical requirements for leaders.
- Music proficiency (vocal and/or instrumental) with ability to lead congregational singing.
- Experience in leading worship in a church setting preferred.
- Strong leadership, organizational, and communication skills.
- Ability to work collaboratively with pastoral staff, volunteers, and the congregation.
- A call to ministry.

Hours & Compensation:

- Part-time (approximately 5–10 hours per week).

- Hours include Sunday worship services, midweek rehearsal, and occasional special services.
- Compensation commensurate with experience.
